The Opportunity

Over the past eight months we developed a series of thematically constructed buy lists of stocks that we believe will play a role in the energy transition.

- Australian Critical Minerals (ACM)
- Australian Rare Earths (ARE)
- Australian Iron Ore (AIO)
- Australian Sustainable Portfolio (ASP)

In our previous research notes, we introduced each of the above thematic ideas on a standalone basis. Now we shift gears to maintain these idea pools, in a single series of notes to go forward. These research notes will focus on both new portfolio ideas, and news flow, the portfolio gardening, and whether we have changed our views on stocks. Here we do a bit of both. We add **Syrah Resources** as an extra holding to Australian Critical Minerals. On the gardening side, we discuss recent developments for **Genex Power** and **ASM (Holdings)**.

Our Unified Sustainability Framework

In our general scheme for analysing innovations, as shown in Exhibit 1, and Exhibit 2, different stocks are classified according to their potential role in meeting needs of the energy transition, and lower environmental impact industrial activities.

Unlike the mainstream of Environment, Social and Governance (ESG) approaches to scoring companies on behaviour, we focus on which firms produce products essential to other firms when navigating the energy transition. These are firms in: **materials**; **engineering**; **building fixtures**; **waste and water management**; **recycling**, **mobility**; and the **generation and storage of electricity**.

It is worth noting that many investors prefer not to invest in many of the sectors we mention. That is due to the belief that one must purposefully invest in a **low carbon portfolio**. Our philosophical views differ from the conventional wisdom. Investing only in low carbon activities is likely to lead to shortages of vital goods. It further ignores the need to invest in **capital equipment** and **process technology** to abate emissions and generate the products we need.

The Role of Graphite in Battery Anodes

In a previous note on the electric vehicle metals sector, we left out one vital commodity that is not actually a metal. This is **graphite**, which ironically is a pure form of **elemental carbon**. Oddly enough, the mineral graphite is proving essential to make the anode material in lithium-ion batteries. Nature has played a small trick on us here. To abate carbon emissions from fossil fuels, we need pure carbon to make the storage batteries for electrification. Our preferred pick in this area is **Syrah Resources**.

Portfolio Housekeeping

The four themes we have explored so far are shown in Exhibit 3, along with the report date for when we first discussed the theme and created the portfolio. Our notes have not dealt with weightings, since the appropriate place for that analysis is in the context of what other securities an investor may own. This is a role for your financial adviser or stockbroker.

Exhibit 4 and Exhibit 5 reprise the companies that are in our research universe, and what they do. The twin tables at Exhibit 6 and Exhibit 7 round out the current alpha rankings for each stock, plus a simple mnemonic for which thematic we assigned it to. The tables should be cross-referenced with Exhibit 3.

Among our current themes, ACM is doing the best and has a good prospective ranking. ARE is doing the worst, as rare earth firms have been under some pressure due to the leader, Lynas Rare Earths, being caught up in market speculation over license renewals for its Gebeng plant in Malaysia. We think the stock is presenting very good value. We also like ASM (Holdings) for related reasons. Investors are impatient on the Toongi mine development, but the firm strategy is to shore up its downstream metals refining opportunity to lock in future mine offtake. Lastly, Genex Power is unloved after their takeover suitor pulled out. They hit a subterranean stream which will require some rework of the engineering plan and another \$10-15M AUD of capital cost. That is unwelcome, but we do not believe it will derail one of the very few large energy storage projects.
